

ORDINANCE NO. 331-02-2020
(Order and Notice of May 2, 2020 Election)
(Aldermen Places 1, 4 and 5)

AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWN OF SHADY SHORES, DENTON COUNTY, TEXAS, CALLING FOR AN ELECTION TO BE HELD ON MAY 2, 2020 TO ELECT THE TOWN COUNCIL MEMBERS FOR PLACES 1, 4 AND 5; PROVIDING FOR EARLY VOTING; PROVIDING FOR ORDER AND NOTICE OF THE ELECTION; AND PROVIDING FOR OTHER MATTERS RELATING TO THE ELECTION.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF SHADY SHORES, DENTON COUNTY, TEXAS:

SECTION 1. The Mayor of the Town of Shady Shores, Texas, with the concurrence of the Town Council, orders an election to be held on May 2, 2020, for the purpose of electing Town Council Members for Places 1, 4 and 5. The elected Council Members will serve two-year terms.

SECTION 2. The polling place in the Town of Shady Shores for this election is as follows:

SECTION 3. The polls on May 2, 2020 shall be open from 7:00 a.m. until 7:00 p.m.

SECTION 4. Said election shall be conducted in accordance with the Texas Election Code and only registered qualified voters of the Town of Shady Shores will be entitled to vote.

SECTION 5. Early voting by personal appearance shall be available at the Denton County Elections Office, 701 Kimberly Lane Suite A101, Denton, Texas, and at locations to be posted later, on dates and during the hours determined by the County Elections Office.

Applications for ballot by mail shall be requested from and mailed to the Denton County Elections Office, Attn: Elections Administrator, 701 Kimberly Drive, Suite A101, Denton Texas 76208. Applications for ballots by mail must be **received** no later than the close of business on April 17, 2020. Various exceptions to this deadline may apply.

SECTION 6. Candidates must adhere to the filing deadlines accordingly. Candidate packets are available in the City Secretary's office. The candidate filing deadlines for the General Election for Council Members are as follows:

January 15, 2020 through February 14, 2020 at 5:00 p.m.
