

ORDINANCE NO. 178-2-2006

AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWN OF SHADY SHORES, TEXAS, TEMPORARILY CLOSING A PORTION OF A STREET RIGHT-OR-WAY KNOWN AS JUNE STREET BETWEEN 5TH STREET AND LAKESHORE ROAD; RESERVING ALL EXISTING PUBLIC UTILITY EASEMENT RIGHT OF OTHERS, IF ANY, WHETHER APPARENT OR NON-APPARENT, AERIAL, SURFACE, UNDERGROUND OR OTHERWISE; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the Town Council of the Town of Shady Shores, acting pursuant to law upon the finding of the Town Council that the public health, safety and welfare require the closing of the hereinafter described street right-of-way, and is of the opinion and finds that said street right-of-way is not suitable or necessary for traffic in its current condition, pending a review of the fire lane and access to the area; subject to the reservations and conditions of this ordinance; **NOW, THEREFORE,**


BE IT ORDINED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF SHADY SHORES, TEXAS;

SECTION 1. That the Town of Shady Shores hereby temporarily closes to public vehicular traffic the right-of-way described specifically by plat identified in the attached Exhibit A, and generally described as June Street between 5th Street Lakeshore Road, subject to all existing public utility easement rights of others, if any, whether apparent or non-apparent, aerial, surface, underground or otherwise. The Town may reopen the road on completion of an access and fire lane study and report in the Old Town area, and/or upon its reconstruction or at any other time determined by the Town Council. The town reserves unto itself the right at any time to lay, construct, and maintain water, storm and sanitary sewer lines and appurtenances in and upon the real property closed to public use.

SECTION 2. This Ordinance shall take effect immediately from and after its passage as the law in such cases provides.
